

How can you tell a butterfly weed?

Butterfly Weed (Asclepias tuberosa)

1. Flower color ranges from orange to yellow.
2. Typically grow in clumps, stalks 1-3' tall.
3. NO milky sap is present.
4. Very hairy stems.



TROPICAL MILKWEED



If you have tropical milkweed in your garden, prune stalks to ~6 inches during fall and winter to help eliminate OE spores that may be present.

BEST PRACTICES

- When buying milkweed, ensure no pesticides
- Plant milkweed in your sunniest location
- Wear gloves when handling milkweed
- Water new milkweed often
- Don't plant near house foundation
- Cut back plants in the fall
